According to the PRIMHD (Programme for the Integration of Mental Health Data) national collection of mental health information, a total of 10,270 people were subject to either compulsory assessment and/or treatment under the Mental Health (Compulsory Assessment and Treatment) Act 1992³ (The Mental Health Act), during 2013.

Of this total, 4,902 people underwent an initial period of assessment of (five days) under section 11 of the Mental Health Act. 4,433 people underwent the second period of assessment (14 days) under section 13, and 2,838 people underwent a final period of assessment (up to six weeks) under sections 14(4), 15(1) or 15(2).

Over the course of 2013, 5,709 people were subject to a section 29 order to receive treatment in the community, 2,362 people were subject to a section 30 inpatient order to receive treatment in a mental health inpatient facility and 1,084 people were subject to a section 31 order (inpatient leave in the community).

As at 31 December 2013 there were a total of 6,344 people under any of the aforementioned sections of the Mental Health Act in New Zealand.
