Please provide the names of the people or businesses who were approved to buy under the "special forestry test"? And what if any conflicts of interest may be involved?

Regarding the second part of your request, outlined above, please note that that information can be found on our decision summaries, which are published monthly on our website at www.linz.govt.nz/overseas-investment/latest/latest-decisions/search-decision-summaries. Decision summaries provide information on all applications that have been decided by the Overseas Investment Office.

Regarding your query on conflicts of interest, Land Information New Zealand has a conflict of interest policy for all staff.
