Examination misconduct (2 cases)	Student Academic Conduct Statute	The penalties imposed included:** <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Issued with letter of reprimand.</li> <li>• Exam paper not marked and course grade reduced to fail.</li> <li>• Course grade reduced to maximum of C-</li> <li>• Suspension for one semester.</li> <li>• Fines of up to \$250.</li> </ul>
Coursework misconduct (40 cases)	Student Academic Conduct Statute	The penalties imposed included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Letter of reprimand.</li> <li>• Assignment/test given a mark of zero/not marked.</li> <li>• Course not credited to degree programme.</li> <li>• Course grade reduced to maximum C- grade.</li> <li>• Course grade reduced to a grade of "Fail".</li> <li>• Fines of up to \$1000.</li> </ul>
Non-academic misconduct (8 cases)	Statute for Student Discipline Addressing Bullying, Harassment and Discrimination Policy Campus Rules IT Acceptable Use Policy	The penalties imposed included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Issued with letter of reprimand.</li> <li>• Suspension for up to two years.</li> <li>• Fines of up to \$1000.</li> </ul>
Review (15 cases)	Student Academic Conduct Statute	11 cases upheld on review.
