Thank you for your further email of 8 June 2022 to Hon Chris Hipkins, the previous Minister for COVID-19 Response, regarding vaccination, particularly the legal basis for businesses being able to require My Vaccine Pass for entry.

Access conditions to premises based on vaccination status are currently a business decision derived from private property rights rather than from COVID-19 legislation.

Most businesses can limit access to their premise to people with My Vaccine Pass, or similar, as a condition of entry. Businesses can do this as long as:

- it doesn't breach any contractual restrictions (for example in a lease or under a franchise agreement)
- it doesn't breach any law, such as the COVID-19 Protection Framework Order (which prohibits certain places requiring My Vaccine Pass, like supermarkets and pharmacies) or the Human Rights Act 1993.
