Request for information

- Reason for surveiling these people
- Legality of watching these people
- Police hours spent monitoring this group

Any and all internal memos, reporting, external memos, reporting to government agencies completed in conjunction with this political operation where the New Zealand brown shirts are targeting the backbone of New Zealand. Shame on you.

Police does not have any information that fits the description you have provided. Your request is therefore refused under s 18(e) of the OIA, as the information you requested does not exist.
