## Request for information – Our Reference IR-01-22-15809

Thank you for your information request of 31/05/2022 requesting information with regards to a trespass notice.

## You requested:

According to the Official Information Act i am here by requesting all information regarding the trespass notice served by NZ Police served on the occupiers at the former NZ Defense property known as Watts Peninsula (Fort Ballance) on or about 24th May 2022 For your ease of reference and the interests of clarity a copy of the document can be viewed at the link below.

To make it clear i am requesting all information on the Police file regarding this matter, in particular i request the Police to identify the Occupier of the property who is referred to in the Trespass Notice.

This request is urgent due to the nature of the wording of the trespass notice which warns of a possible term of imprisonment and fine.

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 and the Privacy Act 2020. Response below:

- I was unable to access the trespass notice from your link so I have provided a copy below.
- A group of people had set up an unauthorised camp at 270 270A Massey Road, Maupuia, Wellington.
- Both LINZ and NIWA delegated authority to Police to issue a trespass notice to the group, giving the group until 25/05/2022 to remove from the site.
- The trespass notice was served at about 1300hrs on Tuesday the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2022 by Sergeant Mike BYRNE to a spokesperson who the group had nominated to receive the trespass notice on the group's behalf.
- Multiple copies of the trespass notice were provided to the spokesperson.
