Veteran Al Jazeera journalist, Shireen Abu Akleh (a US citizen) was also killed by gunfire in the West Bank allegedly by Israeli sniper fire although this is disputed and investigations are underway to determine the likely cause of death. Abu Akleh's death is the latest episode of violence during weeks of Palestinian attacks in Israel, and Israeli military raids in the West Bank that have seen 18 Israelis and 30 Palestinians killed.
