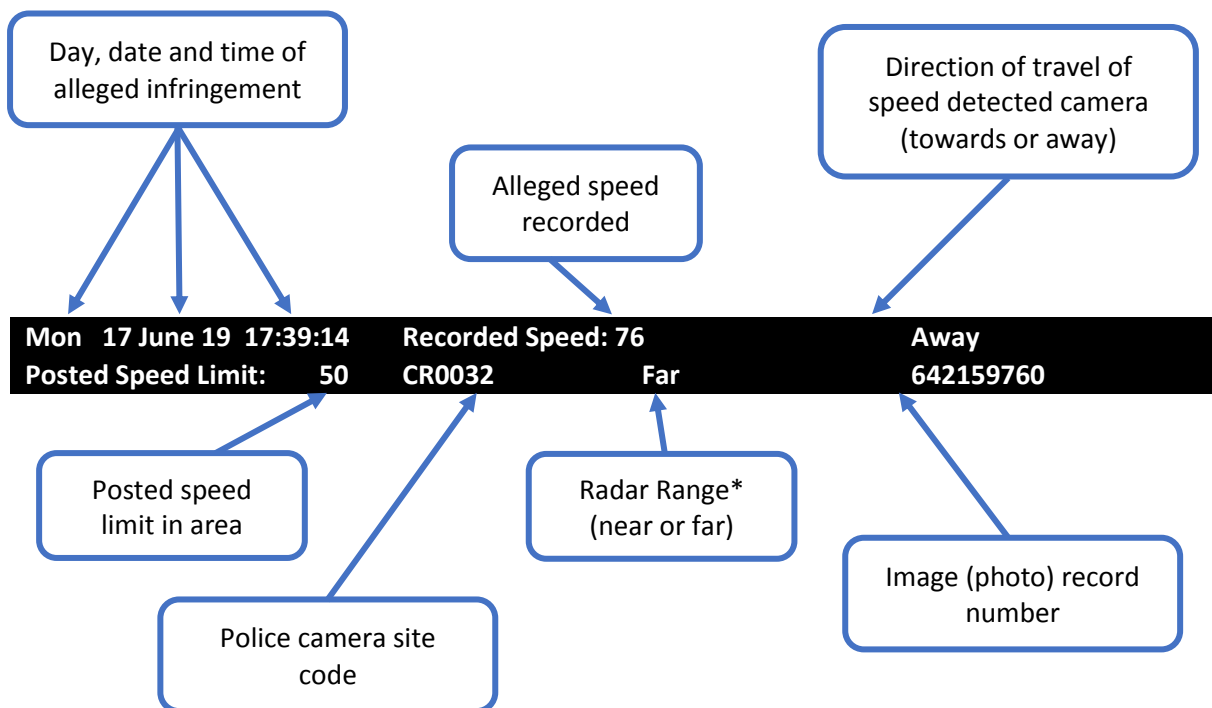
Letter of explanation – Mobile Speed Camera
