


# NZ Superpower campaign 20 June – 31 July 2022



# **Campaign overview**

- Ran 20 June to 31 July 2022
- 4x 30 sec animated videos created
- 2-week radio promo on Mai FM breakfast show #1 music station breakfast show in NZ.
- 7x interviews conducted with people aged 65 and over and written up as case studies.
- 8 media results generated highlighting NZ Super value.





### Mai FM Morning Crew

- 149,000 listeners
- Details about The Retirement Commission and Mai Local Superheroes were housed at the Mai FM WIN section.
- The Retirement Commission Integration page gained 230 page views over the duration of the campaign and 150 of those were unique visitors. 100% tenancy of digital display on the page gained 383 impressions, with a 1.04% click through rate, which is above the industry standard!


