Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 18 September 2022 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I would like to request two documents which are referenced in Waka Kotahi's response to Movement's request to reconsider a trial of lane reallocation on the AHB:

- I & D Committee Paper "Northern Pathway Rescope Update" 22 February 2022*
- Auckland Harbour Bridge Active Mode Provision – Traffic Impact Assessment Phase 2 30 June 2022*

The following documents fall in scope of your request and are enclosed:

- Attachment 1 – Investment and Delivery Committee Paper – Northern Pathway Rescope Update, 1 March 2022
- Attachment 1A – The 'New Northern Pathway', 14 February 2022
- Attachment 2 – Auckland Harbour Bridge Active Mode Provision – Traffic Impact Assessment Phase 2.

Some information in attachments 1 and 1A has been withheld under section 9(2)(f)(iv) of the Act to maintain the current constitutional conventions protecting the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers and officials.

Some information in attachment 2 has been withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons.

With respect to the information that has been withheld, I do not consider there are any other factors which would render it desirable, in the public interest, to make this information available.
