  - Tier 2 occupations can apply for the Work to Residence visa.













## Health

Applicants must have an acceptable standard of health (ASH)

 Applicants are required to provide evidence of their health status by providing a General Medical Certificate and a Chest X-ray Certificate

 Some applicants who are assessed as having an unacceptable standard of health may be eligible for a medical waiver

## Character

- Character checks aged 17 and over
- Police certificate from:
  - every country of which they hold citizenship and
  - each country in which the applicant has wed for
     12 months or more (whether on one visit or intermittently) in the last 10 years
- Section 15 or 16 of the Immigration Act 2009
- Persons who have been convicted or involved in certain activities
- Persons who pose a risk to New Zealand's international reputation

## **Police Certificates**

How old must a PC be when an application is lodged?

Less than six months old.

If a PC was submitted with a previous application, can I use StR?

As long as the PC is less than six months old.

What if someone is unable to provide a police certificate? What can they provide instead?

If a TA is satisfied a PC is genuinely unavailable or unduly difficult to obtain from a particular country, then that officer may require the applicant to make and provide a separate statutory declaration in both English and the applicant's own language.

## **English language**

What is the minimum standard of English for principal applicants?

- Acceptable English language test results (no moge than two years old)
- Citizenship of Canada, Republic of Ireland, UK or USA, provided the applicant has spent at least five years in work or education in one or more of those countries or Australia or NZ; or
- a recognised qualification comparable to a NZ level 7 bachelor's degree (or level 8 and above) and gained in Australia, Canada, NZ, Republic of Ireland, UK or USA as a result of study undertaken for at least two academic years (one academic year for level 8 and above) in one or more of those countries.

# **English language**

A principal applicant provides evidence of an English language test from PTE Academic with a score of the from last year. Does this meet the minimum standard?

Yes. Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE Academic): Overall score of 58+

In what case would an applicant need to pre-purchase ESOL tuition?

Partners and dependent children aged 16 and older may pre-purchase ESOL tuition.





### **Green List Tier 1 occupations**

### **Risk Considerations**






