- Applicants must have an acceptable standard of health (ASH)
- Applicants are required to provide evidence of their health status by providing a General Medical Certificate and a Chest X-ray Certificate
- Some applicants who are assessed as having an unacceptable standard of health may be eligible for a medical waiver

- Character checks aged 17 and over

- Persons who pose a risk to New Zealand's international reputation

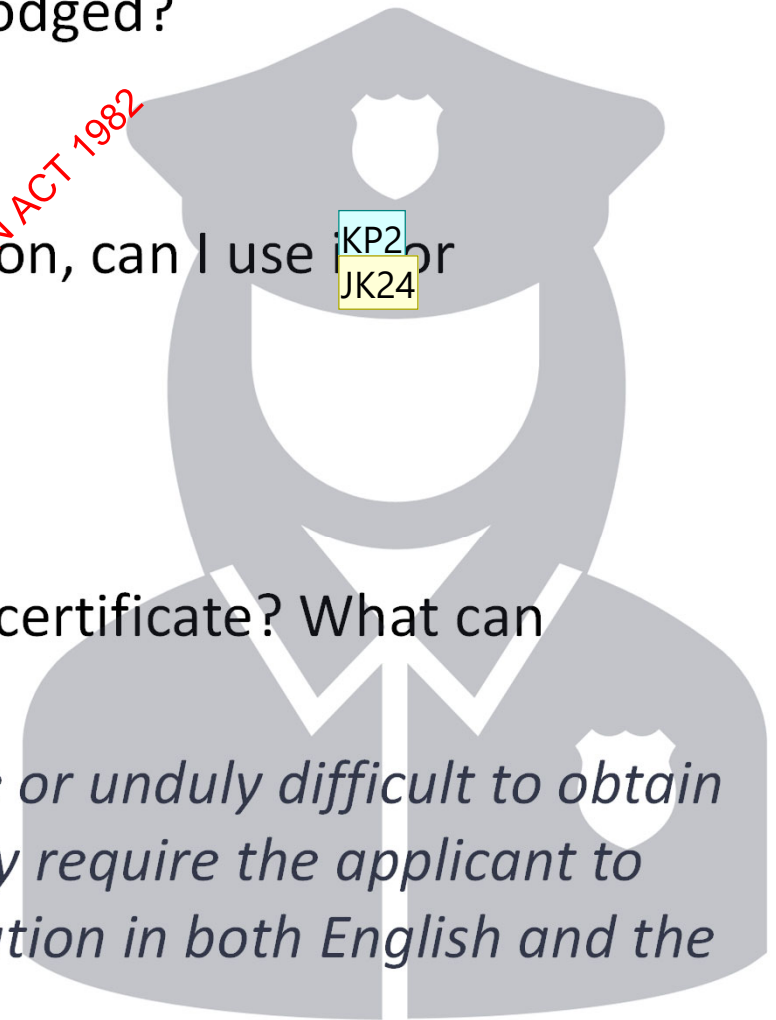
Less than six months old.

If a PC was submitted with a previous application, can I use it for StR?

As long as the PC is less than six months old.

What if someone is unable to provide a police certificate? What can they provide instead?

If a TA is satisfied a PC is genuinely unavailable or unduly difficult to obtain from a particular country, then that officer may require the applicant to make and provide a separate statutory declaration in both English and the applicant's own language.

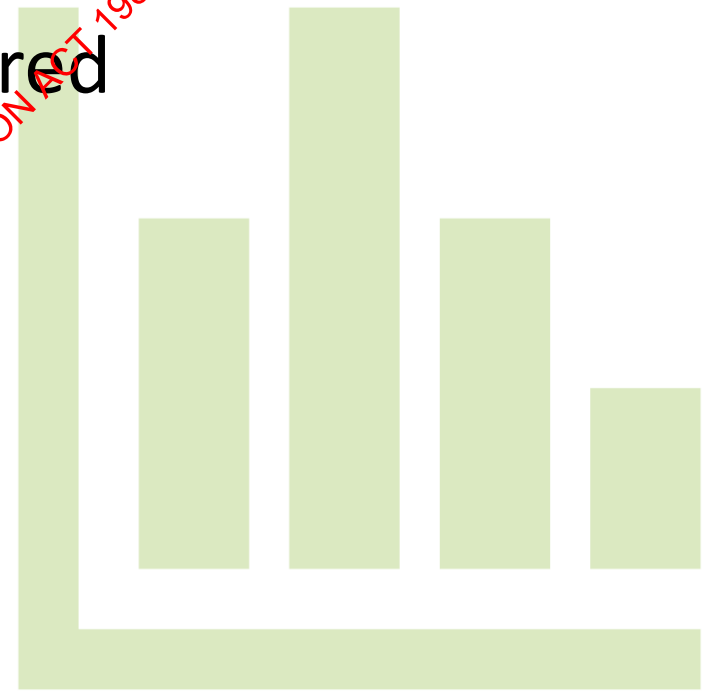
