Document FIVE: 'Beyond 'Islamist' & 'Far Right': Understanding the Long Tail of Online Extremism in New Zealand (Draft Copy):

Document SEVEN: New Zealand Online Extremism: International Influences (Draft Copy)

This document, compiled by the Institute for Strategic Dialogue, provides a snapshot of the influence of international extremist communities on the New Zealand extremist landscape. A background to the internationalisation of extremism in the digital age is presented alongside an analysis of the interplay between domestic and international references associated with extremism. A brief historical examination of international influences on New Zealand extremism is made, preceding an examination of the landscape of 'current' relevant influences on New Zealand extremism.

Document NINE: 'Beyond 'Islamist' & 'Far Right': Understanding the Long Tail of Online Extremism in New Zealand (Draft Copy)

This document, compiled by the Institute of Strategic Dialogue, provides a picture of the changing extremist landscape in New Zealand over a two-year period. Key changes and continuities are examined alongside an assessment of how broader extremist trends are reflected in New Zealand alongside an analysis of possible developments going forward. A significant shift in ideological streams, platform use and demographics within the New Zealand extremist ecosystem is examined.
