Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), transferred to Inland Revenue on 21 November 2022 from the Minister of Revenue. You requested the following:

*Please provide the governments revenue attributed to all taxes for the years you have been in power – can you break it down into the various components of tax GST, fuel, PAYE, business, emissions – please break it down into all the tax categories. Actually make it the following years: 2014-2022.*

### **Information publicly available**

The information you have requested for revenue data by tax type for the 2014-2022 years is publicly available on the Treasury's website at: <https://www.treasury.govt.nz/publications/tax-outturn-data/tax-outturn-data-september-2022>.

The data can be found in the *Tax Outturn Data Monthly History* spreadsheet and is broken down by month and tax type. Your request is therefore refused under section 18(d) of the OIA, as the information requested is publicly available.
