Official Information Act 1982 request

I am replying to your email of 23 October 2014 in which you have requested, under the Official Information Act 1982, information relating to drink driving statistics for the Wellington region.

You have requested and confirmed in your email of 24 October 2014, statistics regarding the number of people convicted for drink driving offences in the last two years in the following courts:

- Wellington
- Porirua
- Hutt Valley
- Masterton
- Levin

Your email on this date acknowledged that the Ministry of Justice is unable to provide information regarding the suburb that a convicted individual lives in, as this information is court record, which is excluded from the scope of the Official Information Action 1982 under sections under sections 2(6)(a) and (b).

Your response, to an email from the Ministry of Justice on 28 October 2014 agreed to the request for a 20 day extension as a result of the volume of information requested.

The specific data you have requested for each court is:

- the number of people that exceeded breath or blood alcohol limits while driving
- · the number of people convicted for drink driving
- the number of people convicted for drink driving that had previously been convicted of drink driving
- the average fine given to people convicted of drink driving
- the maximum fine given to a person convicted of drink driving
- the average number of hours of community service ordered to people convicted of drink driving
- · the maximum number of hours of community service given to a person convicted of drink driving
- the average number of hours of supervision ordered to people convicted of drink driving
- the highest number of hours of supervision ordered to a person convicted of drink driving
- the number of people from each area that were jailed for drink driving
- the average length of jail terms given to people who were imprisoned for drink driving
- the longest jail term given to a person who was imprisoned for drink driving

The Ministry of Justice compiles statistical information on conviction and sentencing. Without searching every court record we cannot be sure of the classification of drink drive convictions. Courts are excluded from the scope of the Official Information Act 1982 under sections 2(6)(a) and (b).

Searching of court records is governed by the District Court Rules 2014. If you wish to pursue your request you will therefore need to apply to the relevant court registrar. I note that any decision relating to the release of a court record is a judicial decision.

In response to the remainder of your request, please find tables 1 to 7 attached.

Please note with the data:

- the offences counted for drink driving include exceeding the prescribed limit and other offences relating to driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs (eg causing injury/death). About 2% of convictions are in this latter category
- individuals are counted for their most serious drink driving offence per year. They can appear in the data more than once, but only appear once per year
- tables 2, 3, 4 and 6 count numbers of instances that specified sentences were imposed and cannot be directly compared with the number of people convicted
- this information is representative of a point in time and is subject to change
- I have provided data by financial year in order to provide you the most recent data available

If you are not satisfied with my response to your request, you have the right to make a complaint to the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982. The Ombudsman may be contacted by writing to PO Box 10-152, Wellington.

Individuals are considered to have a previous conviction if they have been convicted of a drink driving offence from 1980 up to their most recent drink driving conviction.
