On 10 January 2023, you emailed Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

- "An independent candidate review panel will consider the nominations in 2023 and make recommendations to the Minister for the Public Service" Can you please provide name and bio for this independent candidate review panel. Are they getting paid, if so, how much?
- Also, i noted "More than 100 nominations were received." Can you please specify exactly how many nominations you have received? Are they any nominations are not from the public directly, e,g. nomination received from Ministry of Women or TPK etc

This letter is to advise you that I am transferring your request in full under section 14(b)(i) of the Act, as I believe that the information is not held by Oranga Tamariki, but is held by the Crown Response to the Abuse in Care Inquiry. You can expect to hear from them in due course.
