## Request for information

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request of 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023, in which you asked for information regarding the Royal New Zealand Police College (RNZPC) Independent Advisory Board.

My response to each part of your request can be found below.

 How did you call for public nomination / on what platform you have call for public nominations

Police posted the information on the following channels:

- Police LinkedIn account
- Police public website

Other communication strategies were:

- emails to members of the Commissioners' Focus Forums, former and current Wing Patrons of RNZPC and the Understanding Policing Delivery team.
- internal communications were sent out asking for staff to distribute to their external networks. Channels included: People Leaders' Brief, District Communications mailout, Pānui (on TenOne), and local internal newsletters.
- staff members were also encouraged to communicate the information out to their own networks.
- 2. "how many applications you have received from the public"

As of 23 February 2023, there were 22 expressions of interest.

"how many you have received from other nominating agencies such as TPK or Ministry of women etc."

We have not received any expressions of interest by way of nominating agencies.

4. "how many you have shortlisted"

As of 23 February, the shortlisting process had not commenced, so Police is unable to provide this information.

5. "how many you are intend to appoint"

Shortlisting or appointment have yet to occur, however Police's intention at this stage is to appoint between six and eight members.

"Please supply the pay rate"

Once the Board has been appointed, we will assess the Board's planned work against the Crown bodies fees framework matrix and confirm a meeting fee.
