Official Information Act request for the former Prime Minister's meeting with BlackRock

- A full list of the attendees at this meeting, or failing that for any reason, a partial list
- A summary of topics covered
- Any agreements made, written or otherwise
- Any video footage of all or any part of the meeting
- Any audio recording of all or any part of the meeting

Please forward this to the relevant agency or agencies if any other than yourself might hold this information. I also request that, if records are not available, you request Jacinda Ardern (who after resigning is no longer obligated to answer OIA requests directly, but remains a member of parliament) to supply this to the best of her ability."

The former Prime Minister's meeting with the United States Chamber of Commerce and Blackrock Investment in New York was a roundtable meeting. It was an opportunity to highlight New Zealand's attractive investment environment as well as testing business leaders' views on what settings are important to attract sustainable investment into New Zealand.
