Travel eligibility

- . The People's Republic of China border remains closed to most foreign nationals.
- Check you meet entry, health, and immigration requirements for Mainland China.

Pre-departure test

- All passengers require a negative COVID-19 lest result within 48 hours of the last point of departure to China. This applies to passengers 3 years and older.
 - eg. CHC-AKL-HKG, passengers must receive a negative test result within 48hrs of departing Auckland.
- . Passengers transiting internationally between New Zealand and China (eg. AKL-SYD-PVG) must present a negative COVID-19 PCR test result at check-in. Printed copies are required, electronic copies will not be accepted.
- Passengers travelling a direct flight from New Zealand to China (including AKL-PVG and SYD-AKL-PVG) do not need to present at est result at check-in. Self-administered Rapid Antigen tests (home testing kits) are permitted.

Health declaration

- All passengers must complete an Electronic Health Declaration Form 24 hours prior to arriving in Mainland China. As part of this declaration passengers will confirm that they have completed a negative pre-departure
- · All passengers must display their E-Health Declaration QR code at check-in.

Upon arrival

 Passengers who display any COVID-19 symptoms on arrival in China may be required to take an antigen test, if this produces a positive result they will need to self-quarantine.

Proposed Overseas Travel for 2023: China: March 2023

- 1. I am writing to seek your approval, in principle, to travel to China this month from 22-26 March 2023. The dates are confirmed by China and will include a meeting and dinner with China's new Foreign Minister Qin Gang.

- 3. I consider it is important to have a high level, in person, political engagement in China as a priority. This will be the first high level New Zealand visit to China since former Prime Minister Ardern's truncated visit in April 2019.

- 5. New Zealand officials worked hard to confirm my visit to China throughout the course of the last year. Despite efforts, it did not prove possible until now, including because of China's recently rescinded COVID-19 restrictions.
- 6. My visit to China would deliver on the following objectives:
 - Establish a constructive working relationship with new Chinese Foreign Minister Qin Gang, building on my previous bilateral engagements with his predecessor Wang Yi.

 - Acknowledge the significance of the bilateral relationship and signal New Zealand's ongoing commitment to a relationship consistent with our interests and values
 - Provide an opportunity to engage with China on issues that matter to New Zealand, such as the Pacific, and Antarctica. s6(a)
 - (with regard to China's position on Russia's invasion of Ukraine) as well as register at a high-level New Zealand's concerns including regarding Taiwan, Xinjiang and Hong Kong.
 - Be a tangible demonstration of New Zealand's reconnection and economic recovery strategies, and reassure the business community of New Zealand's constructive engagement with our largest trading partner.

 Engage with our staff, and families, at the Embassy after a challenging three years under China's difficult COVID restrictions.

Outline of Proposed Visit

- 7. The visit would revolve principally around a face-to-face meeting and a meal with Foreign Minister Qin Gang.
- 8. This visit may also include meetings with other senior Chinese officials. For example, MFAT officials will seek a courtesy call on the former Chinese Foreign Minister and newly appointed member of the Chinese Communist Party's Politburo Standing Committee and Director of China's Foreign Affairs Commission, Wang Yi. Officials are also exploring events with NZ business and expatriate communities based in China, women leaders in China, as well as time with the New Zealand Embassy staff and families and resident Pacific Missions.

Flights

9. Flights depart Auckland via Singapore on Wednesday 22 March. I intend to return to New Zealand on Saturday 25 March via Hong Kong into Auckland, arriving Sunday 26 March.

Ministerial Party

10. I propose to be accompanied by one staff member paid for by ministerial resources. Officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade will also accompany me.

Acting Ministers

11. If my travel is approved, I propose that Hon David Parker act as Minister for Foreign Affairs and Minister for Disarmament and Arms Control in my absence.
