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# The Department of Corrections Graphic Identity


## THE LOGO

- ◆ The Department of Corrections logo comprises of the New Zealand coat of arms and the text 'Department of Corrections' in both English and Māori.
- ◆ The updated logo is arranged in a **horizontal** format only. There is no stacked or vertical version available.

- ◆ Please do not redraw the Department of Corrections logo. Electronically sourced artwork should be used in all cases.
- ◆ Do not rearrange or separate the coat of arms from the type. The coat of arms alone does not represent Corrections and should not be used on its own.
- ◆ See [Logo File Types](#) (page 11) when selecting logo files to use.

## CLEAR SPACE

- ◆ The minimum clear space around the logo is determined by the height of the crown, as shown below.



## MINIMUM SIZE

- ◆ To ensure the logo is legible, in particular the Department's Māori name, the minimum logo size is 35 mm wide.
- ◆ Ideally the logo should appear larger than the minimum size, where possible.
- ◆ Strong legibility must be considered in all instances.

# Logo Colour


- ◆ The Department of Corrections logo is printed in one colour on a solid colour background.
- ◆ Do not use the logo on a busy patterned background, or in any way that compromises legibility.
- ◆ The logo colour may be either Corrections Blue or black;
- ◆ Or reversed out in white on black or Corrections Blue.
- ◆ Make sure there is enough contrast between the logo and background to ensure strong legibility in all cases.

# Logo - Incorrect Uses: What Not to Do

- ◆ Please do not redraw the Department of Corrections logo. Electronically sourced artwork should be used in all cases.



- ◆ Do not rearrange, separate the coat of arms from the type, or attempt to redraw either of them.



- ◆ The coat of arms alone does not represent Corrections and should not be used on its own.



- ◆ Do not distort the logo in any way.



- ◆ Do not change the colour of the logo. The logo colour may be either Corrections Blue or black, or reversed out in white on black or Corrections Blue.



- ◆ Do not place text or other graphic elements within the logo clear space. The minimum clear space around the logo is determined by the height of the crown. See [The Department of Corrections Logo - Clear Space](#) (page 3)



- ◆ Do not print or produce the logo smaller than the specified minimum size; 35 mm wide. Ensure the logo is legible, in particular the Department's Māori name.



- ◆ Do not use the logo on a busy patterned background, or in any way that compromises legibility.




- ◆ Never use the logo as a background graphic, or place text or other graphic elements over it.




- ◆ Do not use 'Reducing Re-offending' as a strap line as it is no longer applicable.



# Assigned Colours for Business Groups


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# Secondary Colour Palette

# Logo File Types

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Please use the logo files listed here and on the next page for all communications associated with The Department of Corrections.

## FILE FORMATS

- ◆ **EPS** files are one of the most versatile formats available. These logos are suitable for offset printing. They are vector based, so can be scaled up or down without loss of quality. They can also be placed on different coloured backgrounds.
- ◆ **JPEG** files are for onscreen use only. They are 72dpi, and may be scaled down, but not up in size. Two size variations are available; large and small.
- ◆ **TIFF** files are less versatile. These logos are suitable for offset and digital printing purposes. They are 400dpi and may be scaled down, but not up in size.

## COLOUR FORMATS

- ◆ **SPOT** colours are single colour inks used in offset printing where a separate plate is made for each colour printed. They are also called Pantone® or PMS colours.
- ◆ **CMYK** stands for cyan, magenta, yellow and black, and refers to the colours used in the four colour printing process for offset or laser printing.
- ◆ **RGB** values and colours are suitable for onscreen display or projection based uses.
- ◆ **WEB** refers to the values suitable for internet or web environments.
