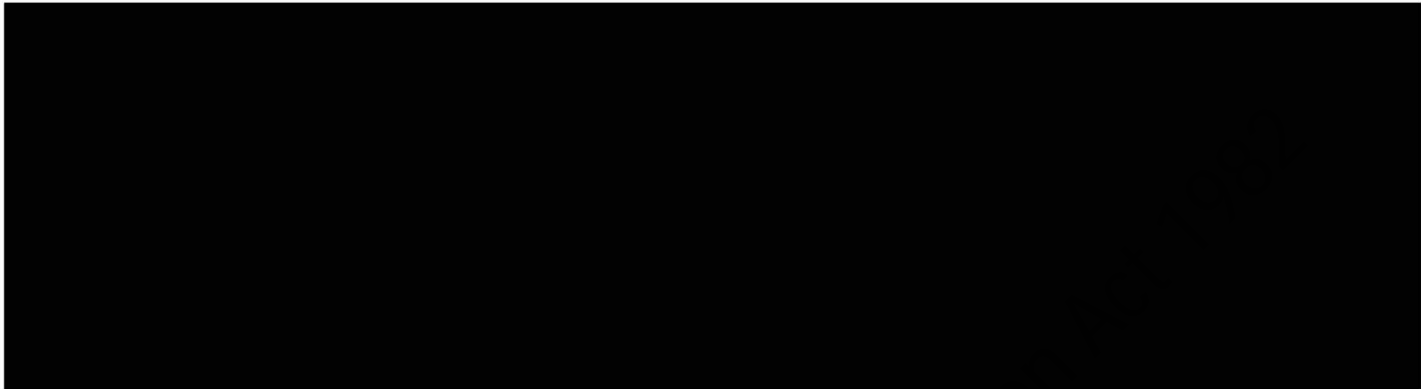
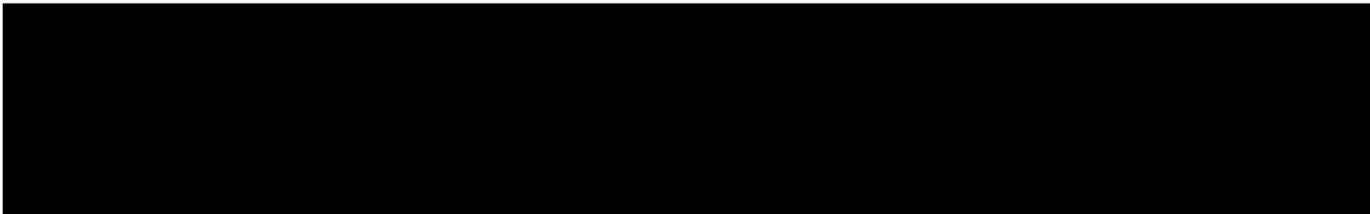
Hi Mark
