Thank you for your email of 14 January 2014 requesting information about Te Mahia Station and the Southern Station Review in regard to when decisions pertaining to these stations will be released.

Auckland Transport has refused your request in accordance with section 17(d) of the LGOIMA as the information requested will soon be publicly available.

We are currently in the process of preparing a report of the Auckland Transport Board's decisions for the Local Boards and this will be made public within (approximately) the next four weeks. In addition to this, the decision to keep Te Mahia station open has already been publicised.

We trust the above information has addressed the matters raised however, should you believe that we have not responded appropriately to your request, you have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the LGOIMA to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsman to seek an investigation and review in regard to this matter.
