

## Resource Consent

Pursuant to the Resource Management Act 1991, the Northland Regional Council (hereinafter called "the Council") does hereby grant a Resource Consent to:

## WHANGAREI DISTRICT COUNCIL, (PARKS DIVISION), PRIVATE BAG 9023, WHANGAREI MAIL CENTRE 0148

(01) To place, use and occupy the coastal marine area with steps for pedestrian access at Dings Bay, 1153 Cove Road, Langs Beach adjacent to Lot 2 DP 34302 at or about location co-ordinates 1737768E 6010434N:

Note: All location co-ordinates in this document refer to Geodetic Datum 2000, New Zealand Transverse Mercator Projection.

## Subject to the following conditions:

- The Consent Holder shall undertake the works generally in accordance with the Frame Group Ltd plan entitled: "Site 8 Dings Bay Track Construction Details"; Ref: 11/076, Drawing No: 20, dated November 2011 (attached).
- 2 The works shall be undertaken outside of school and statutory holiday periods.
- The Consent Holder shall notify the Northland Regional Council's Monitoring Manager in writing of the date that consent will be exercised for the first time at least two weeks beforehand.

- The Consent Holder shall keep the coastal marine area free of debris resulting from the Consent Holder's activities.
- The Consent Holder shall mark the structure with the number **30029** in black lettering on a white background clearly displayed and in such a manner as to be clearly visible from the land.
- In the event of archaeological sites or koiwi being uncovered, activities in the vicinity of the discovery shall cease and the Consent Holder shall contact the New Zealand Historic Places Trust. Work shall not recommence in the area of the discovery until the relevant New Zealand Historic Places Trust approval has been obtained.

7 The Consent Holder shall maintain the structure covered by this consent in good order and repair.

- The Northland Regional Council may, in accordance with Section 128 of the Resource Management Act 1991, serve notice on the Consent Holder of its intention to review the conditions annually during the month of May for any one or more of the following purposes:
  - (a) To deal with any adverse effects on the environment that may arise from the exercise of the consent and which it is appropriate to deal with at a later stage; or
  - (b) To require the adoption of the best practicable option to remove or reduce any adverse effect on the environment.

The Consent Holder shall meet all reasonable costs of any such review.

Advice Note:

The Northland Regional Council may, in accordance with Section 128 of the Resource Management Act 1991, serve notice on the Consent Holder of its intention to review the conditions any time for the following purposes:

- (i) To provide for compliance with rules relating to minimum standards of water quality in any regional plan that has been made operative since the commencement of the consent; or
- (ii) To provide for compliance with any relevant national environmental standards that have been made; or
- (iii) Where there are inaccuracies in the information made available with the application that materially influenced the decision on the application and where the effects of the exercise of consent are such that it is necessary to apply more appropriate conditions.
