## OFFICIAL INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your official information request dated 29 September 2023 for information in relation to 46 residential lots in Ohakune. We apologise for the lateness in responding to your request and acknowledge that we have failed to respond within legislative timeframes.

1./ Please advise what the remaining 2 residential lots are being used for 2./ Who will own the remaining 2 titles, or who will they be transferred to 3./ Please provide any documentation relating to the remaining 2 residential lots, such as agreements, contract for them, discussions around who will get them or who they would/could be allocated to. For the avoidance of doubt, this is any emails, txts, discussions, social media messages, phone calls, etc.

*RDC would have transferred this request to Kainga Ora as it is believed to be more closely connected with the functions of the agency that submitted the resource consent.*
