

In early 1977 a decision was made to discontinue the collection of property and vehicle sales as from 1 April 1977 because of insufficient sample size in non-CPI Revision years. When the results of the 1977-78 year were received, it was apparent that the non-inclusion of the property and vehicle sales had had a marked distorting effect on the Housing and Transportation groups expenditure. Similarly, the total expenditure and the relative percentage expenditure figures for all groups were affected. It was therefore decided to withhold publication of data relating to the Housing and Transportation groups for 1977-78, and also for 1978-79 which are similarly affected.

From 1 April 1979 the collection of property and vehicle sales was re-instituted. This was the commencement of the year of the fuller survey required for the purposes of the revision of the Consumers Price Index. This data will continue to be collected thereafter but the accuracy levels achieved for this type of data will be rather low.

#### COMPARISON BETWEEN 1976-77, 1977-78 AND 1978-79 RESULTS

For comparison with the 1976 results weekly average expenditures on all groups except 'other housing costs', and 'total housing', 'private transportation' and 'total transportation' (all households) are shown.<sup>6</sup>

Expenditure on each group and sub group is expressed as a percentage of total expenditure excluding that on 'other housing costs', 'total housing', 'private transportation' and 'total transportation'.
