With respect to the final part of your request, data on the number of enrolled service users by practice level is not made publicly available as it is commercially sensitive. As such, we are declining to provide this information pursuant to section 9(2)(b)(ii) of the Act, i.e. "...to protect the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or who is the subject of the information".
