

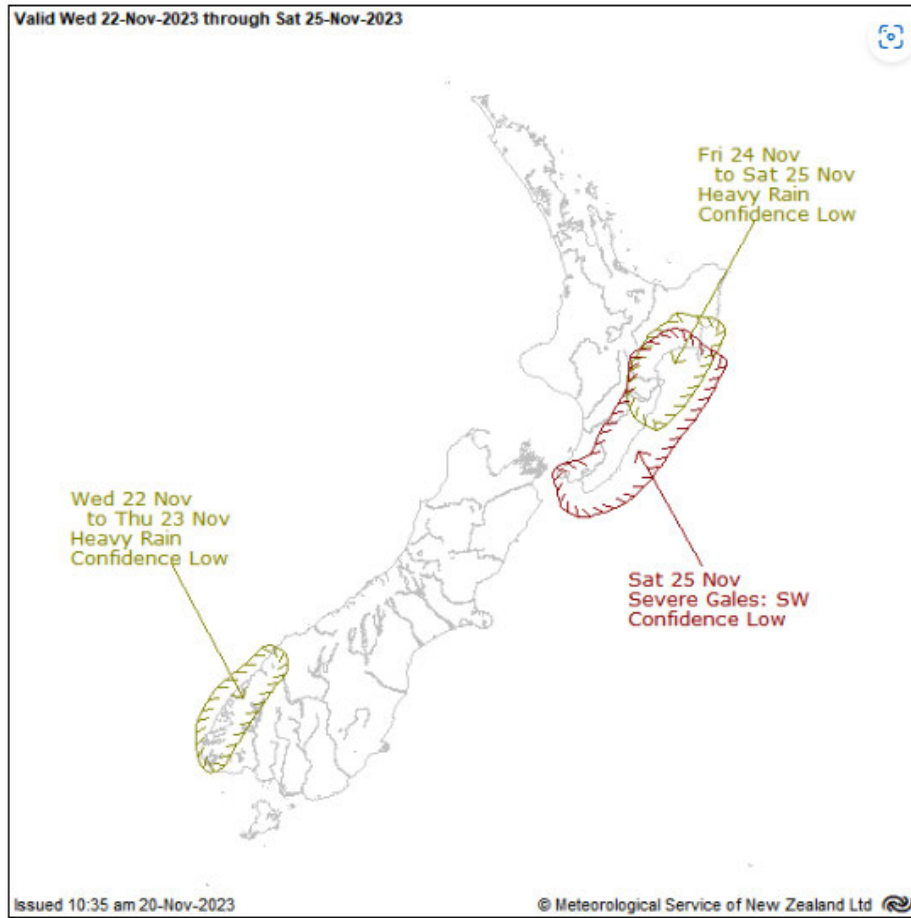

<b>Port Waikato by-election</b>	<p><b>Port Waikato by-election</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All going well</li> <li>Voting materials have been delivered to voting places, except for 5 voting places.</li> <li>No request from scrutineers have been received yet.</li> <li>There are a few cases of C19, and the standby list for staff have been utilised. Currently short of Voting Place Managers as back up support. Will reach out to other electorates for assistance if required.</li> <li>Issue with motorway off and onramp access – there may be impact on transporting materials</li> <li>The counts will take place at voting places tomorrow.
