We do cite Vision's complaint in our response to Freedoms and concluded by saying: On 9 October, the Commission received a complaint from Vision New Zealand regarding a social media post by an individual which linked voting for Te Pati Māori to receiving kai at the Manurewa Marae. The Electorate Manager contacted the Marae again. The Marae confirmed again that they are providing kai to anyone who comes to the voting place, and this is not conditional on whether they have voted or not and not linked to voting for any particular party.
