Thank you for contacting Auckland Transport on 13 May 2015 requesting a copy of the detailed calculations used to create the chart "PT Subsidy per Passenger Kilometre" from the Monthly Transport Indicators Report for March 2015.

Please find attached the raw data used in creating the PT Subsidy per Passenger Kilometre chart.

Please note the following definitions and calculations:

- Subsidy per passenger kilometre is the subsidy divided by the passenger kilometres.
- The subsidy is the operating cost of providing Public Transport services, less the fare revenue, plus any concessionary fare scheme payment (excluding SuperGold payments).
- Passenger kilometres is the number of passenger boardings times the average kilometres per boarding (calculated as point to point for train and ferry, and by using stages travelled for bus).

We trust this information has addressed the matters raised however, should you believe that we have not responded appropriately to your request, you have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the LGOIMA to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsman to seek an investigation and review in regard to this matter.
