# B2 Provider Specific Terms and Conditions

## **Vulnerable Children Act 2014**

According to section 15 of the Vulnerable Children Act 2014, children's services cover the following:

Thereafter, you will review the policy at least every three years. In accordance with the requirements set out in section 19(a) and (b) of the Vulnerable Children Act 2014, your child protection policy must apply to the provision of children's services (as defined in section 15 of the Act), must be written and must contain provisions on the identification and reporting of child abuse and neglect in accordance with section 15 of the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989.

## **Worker Safety Checks**

You acknowledge that under the Vulnerable Children Act 2014, new requirements to conduct staff safety checks are to be introduced. You will ensure that you keep up to date with developments in this area so that when the safety checking requirements come into force you are able to meet these requirements.
