Dear Ms O'Connell-Rapira

Thank you for your email of 20 May requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

'I would like to know how much the climate change consultation has cost the taxpayer and if possible I would like to see the breakdown of the budget for the overall project please'

The scope of this request has been interpreted as the costs incurred by the Ministry for the Environment and any other Government departments during the preparation and implementation of the public consultation on New Zealand's post-2020 climate change contribution. Normal costs of staff time have not been included in our response.

The table below outlines the costs involved in the public consultation process, broken down into sub-categories.

Costs are still being finalised, and a number of invoices have not yet come in. Where possible we have provided exact costs, but in other cases we have provided the approximate costs. We expect that the total cost will be between \$105,000 and \$115,000. All costs exclude GST.
