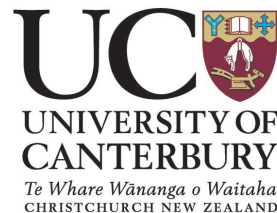

Official Information Act request OIA 24.131 MATH199 grades

I refer to the Official Information Act request dated 12 August 2024 for information relating to MATH199 at the University of Canterbury (UC). You have specifically requested:

- *I request the number of students taking the AIMS MATH199 STAR course each year. Out of these, how many began study at the University of Canterbury the following year(s).*
- *I request the number of students who received an A+ grade in the course each year, and out of those how many began study at the University with MATH199 AIMS scholarships each year.*
- *I request the number of students who began study at the University with MATH199 STAR scholarships, and what the average grade % of the recipients were, each year.*

I refer to the partial response to this request sent to you on 20 September 2024. This letter is the final part of that response.

Please see attached the number of students that obtained an A+ grade from 2014 – 2023 in MATH199. For further information on UC's grading scale, please see [here](#). A student who obtains an A+ is offered a MATH199 scholarship on the condition that they enrol at UC. Therefore, the number of students who began study with a MATH199 scholarship (which was previously provided on 20 September) also answers the second part of this question.
