## Official Information Act request: [Luke] Honours process

Further, you said "correspondence to proposed recipients as to whether they wish to accept a proposed honours appointment or award has been sent by the Clerk of the Executive Council on behalf of the Governor-General, rather than by the Official Secretary of Government House." can you please let me know when the correspondence to proposed recipients will be sent after the meetings. e.g. within 2 weeks?

The Honours process remains the same as that set out in our response to your request of 25 October 2023 and your initial request of 31 May 2018. The date of the last meeting of the Cabinet Appointments and Honours Committee for each list –Queen's/ King's Birthday (QB/KB) and New Year (NY) – for the last five years is set out below:
