

Port Serious Harms Notified to WorkSafe New Zealand (1 January 2011 to 31 December 2014)

INFORMATION RELEASE

The Request

Lianne Dalziel, Mayor of Christchurch, requested the number of port serious harms notified to WorkSafe New Zealand (WorkSafe) from 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2014.

The Response

From 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2014, WorkSafe received 132 notifications of serious harm at ports. See Table 2 below for further information.
