Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request received 6 October 2024, in which you requested:

the number of infringements issued against rule 4.4(1): Driver fails to give way to road user on footpath, cycle path, or shared path when entering/exiting driveway I would like to see number of infringements issued against this rule in the time period of 2010-2024, across all of New Zealand.

I refer you to Table 1 below.

Table 1: Number of infringement offences for entering or exiting a driveway without giving way to a road user on a footpath, cycle path, or shared path. 2010 to 2024. \*Please note that 2024 data is to 30 September.
