SIRRL requires a Resource Consent before it can commence construction, meanwhile preparations are underway to commence construction [s 9\(2\)\(b\)\(ii\)](#) upon receiving a Resource Consent.

Please clarify if S&P agreement is unconditional and if you own the land.

The S&P is subject to approval from the Overseas Investment Office (OIO) and a Resource Consent being granted. SIRRL has been given approval to purchase the land from the OIO, the letter of confirmation included the following statement - **The transaction is not contrary to New Zealand's national interest .**

Once a Resource Consent is granted the S&P becomes unconditional and SIRRL has to settle the land purchase [s 9\(2\)\(b\)\(ii\)](#)
