Official Information Act 1982 request: Open Government Partnership

Thank you for your email to the Ministry of Justice (the Ministry) of 24 October 2024, requesting information relating to commitment 7 of the Open Government Partnership (the OGP), under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Specifically, you requested:

Under section 12 of the OIA, please provide all documents regarding strengthening scrutiny mechanisms in line with commitment 7 of the OGP.
