I refer to your official information request dated 2 July 2015, requesting:

- 1) What nationality is he?
- 2) Is he a NZ resident or citizen?
- 3) How is he paid? And by whom?
- 4) Is his payment for services above the minimum wage?
- 5) What qualifications does he have with regard interpreting?
