



## **Location:**

Northland to Wellington & and some South Island city activations

## **Date and Time:**

Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November to Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November

## **Background/Methodology:**

Due a hīkoi (march) taking place, we are expecting some disruption to the State Highway network through many vehicles on the network, planned marches in town centers and overnight camping at local maraes. We have a confirmed overnight destinations they plan to use with dates in place, but we do not know to what extent there will be congestion. There are reports of up to 50,000 participants with 1 or 2 vans working as a relay for runners who plan to run the distance, but this may not be for the whole journey. There are concerns other protest groups may use this as an opportunity to voice their own message, but the organizers have assured they will be separate and independent from the Hikoi.

Police will not intervene in the Hikoi unless the drivers are behaving in a dangerous manner e.g people sitting in the bed of the Utes or swerving to cut people off from passing them etc

Due to the impact, we will use our NIEMS and DYNAC Platforms to advertise these delays if they occur. Social media posts will be handled separately with the Travel Information Team. Our action timeline will begin from the date where the Hikoi will enter our AO.

## Notification Channels

After the Hikoi leaves Hastings we should monitor the Manawatu police channel for any updates in congestion and any requests for messaging or signal changes.

Palmerston North police will have their DCC activated, and they have been told to contact WTOC either on the 0800 number or the police channel. Police will be a key resource as we do not have good visibility in Palmerston North but have assets we can use to support.

## Sit Rep:

A sitrep is to be produced and released by a Team Leader or Senior at 5:30pm from Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November. On Friday 15<sup>th</sup>, WTOC will feed into the sitrep as it crosses over into our boundary. ATOC will release this final one.

ATOC will be producing their own sitrep and will stop monitoring when the convoy leaves their ATOC area of operation. Please use the National Distribution list for the most up to date list.

The sit rep should include CCTV screenshots if available, maps showing congestion, screenshots of any relevant social media comments or messages. This should highlight the Hikoi movements and what road conditions were observed.

## SH2 Petone to Ngauranga:

There is a high possibility of a splinter group walking from Petone foreshore to Wellington CBD via SH2. We don't know the estimated numbers, but could be upwards of 1000. We are in talks with police about their expectation for how contractors will support this section, but likely to be an ad hoc and fluid incident. [DYNAC Plan 3](#) has been created as a guide if there is a lane impacted, but can be changed as needed. During this time, its important to remain in constant comms with Police and WTA units who will be nearby to manage any disruption and provide a safety element to all other road users.
