HĪKOI MŌ TE TIRITI WILL CONSIST OF 3 TYPES OF ACTIVATIONS

- 1 HĪKOI**
Moving on foot at main rally points. (A special designated group of runners will cover ground between rally points).
- 2 CONVOY**
Convoy by vehicle from one destination to another.
- 3 ACTIVATION**
Rallying together in large groups to make noise, whakawhanaunga & kōrero.

The health and safety of ALL people over the course of this hikoi is a priority. There will be safety marshals along the way and we expect for everyone to ensure safety on the road and in vehicles is maintained to the highest standard. This includes safe and calm behaviour.

Please ensure you have prepared enough kai and wai to sustain your whānau for the duration of the hikoi. Please also ensure you prepare for all weather scenarios; warm clothing, wet weather gear, hats and sunblock.

There is an expectation that everyone prioritises the safety, care and needs of our kaumātua and our tamariki. Please look out for them. Write your name and phone number on your tamariki hands in the event they decide to take off for a play and can't find you.

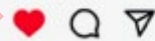

Summary of Conversations with [REDACTED] POC for National Hikoi

November 6

After a voice message was left to call [REDACTED] back I made arrangements to call at 6pm

- Introduction of myself as the POC from NZTA
- [REDACTED] explained the intent and purpose of what they were trying to achieve
- [REDACTED] wanted to know what NZTA would do to support the hikoi
- Would we consider providing traffic management throughout NZ
- My starting point was we were concerned about the impacts that the event will have on the highway and impacts to our customers
- [REDACTED] was not concerned about that and wanted us to work together
- [REDACTED] agreed to send whatever planning documents [REDACTED] had for NZTA to get a feel for the hikoi scale and impacts

November 7

- More information sharing discussions
- I explained we didn't want the hikoi going over the Auckland Harbour bridge
- Talked about the impacts to the bridge and the risks
- [REDACTED] expressed concerns s 9(2)(g)(i) [REDACTED]
- [REDACTED] to facilitate numbers across the Auckland Harbour Bridge (AHB)
- [REDACTED] is meeting with Police today
- [REDACTED] advised that with the change of reading of the Principles Bill in Parliament today, the interest in the Hikoi had ramped up and people are frustrated even more
- s 9(2)(g)(i) [REDACTED]
- [REDACTED] and a couple of others have driven the entire Hikoi routes and are confident in their plans and that of the relay runners
- They are bringing into the planning a Traffic Management Company with over 60 years experience.
- The way they intend to run the relay now is:
 - A police car in front
 - The runners who will run 250 metres
 - A van who picks up the runner
 - Another van that drops off another runner
 - A truck from the company with all the cones etc on will be at the back of the runners
 - The company is bringing 15 of his staff on the hikoi
 - [REDACTED] described having the Maori Wardens across NZ activated and [REDACTED] is working very hard with them to make sure they know their roles
 - There is training in Auckland on Sunday to bring volunteers (380) up to speed with safety and the role they will have on the AHB
 - [REDACTED] described receiving outstanding support from Wellington City Council, [REDACTED] also explained that there are free buses and trains being put on by WCC
- [REDACTED] was open and transparent
- Second phone call to [REDACTED] explaining that we were going to support with walking over Auckland Harbour Bridge
- [REDACTED] was grateful of the news

November 13

- Conversations on the day of the Auckland Harbour bridge crossing
- Understanding the feeling and the hikoi's compliance with our requirements
- 2nd phone call – [REDACTED] explaining the hikoi's intention to walk not walk on the Southern Motorway – [REDACTED] called me after I had text [REDACTED]

- 3rd phone call that I made was explaining we may have to push the time to work across the bridge back by an hour
- [REDACTED] said it won't happen, we are ready to go
