(Infringement = \$20 - \$97)

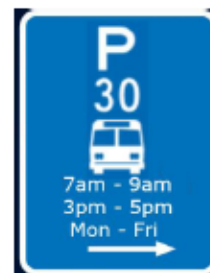

**NOP** Parked a vehicle on a road for more than the authorised maximum time a vehicle may park there as indicated by a parking sign.

**Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 (SR 2004/427) (as at, 11 December 2009)****Part 6.4 Parking contrary to notice, traffic sign, or marking.**

- (1) A driver or person in charge of a vehicle must not stop, stand, or park the vehicle on any part of a road contrary to the terms of a notice, traffic sign, or marking that—
- indicates that stopping, standing, or parking vehicles is prohibited, limited, or restricted; and
  - is on or adjacent to the road; and
  - is authorised by a road controlling authority under the Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004.
