Event Type MIN	Full Name         Minor Event	Alarm activation (residential) Fires in Structures presumed out Fires involving: chimney clothing bin telephone box post box (not attached to building) power pole rubbish (incinerators) gas cylinders (non-commercial & outside) inside a domestic oven cars motorbikes caravans under tow small boats, yachts, launches under 10m Microlights/gliders/hang gliders/paragliders (for crashes, see RESC) motor mowers Cats up trees and similar non-entrapment animals Fuel spillages (outside property) less than 30 litres
		no danger to property or vegetation

MVC	Motor Vehicle Crash	Motor vehicle crash where all people are out of the vehicles
MVRESC	Motor Vehicle Crash Rescue	Motor vehicle crash rescue, where there is someone inside, or they are trapped or can't get out, or if the caller is uncertain.
MVCHEVY	Motor Vehicle Crash - Heavy Rescue	Motor vehicle crash heavy rescue that involves a heavy vehicle (train, truck, bus, tractor, etc) or any vehicle crash into a building or structure.
