Hi [redacted] yes we have had two just recently go to [redacted] and both with very good experiences. I was just waiting to collect a bit more data from the two that we sent to England - [redacted] London, surgeon [redacted], at about the same time, one was a patient of yours, to ensure that we could provide good reasons for provider preference on a number of levels.

However my concern at this stage is that although the experience for the two who went to England for their surgery was also good, including supportive follow up in NZ when there was a problem, we have not been able to get any response from them for some time which makes it a bit difficult to include them in the assessment.

If you just include this email in your application indicating that we are trying to establish a preferred supplier and that the Ministry will not make a decision about a provider for your patient/s without your agreement.

They are requesting referral to Dr [redacted] is a reconstructive urologist and plastic surgeon who performs FTM metoidioplasty surgery in [redacted], California. He is the only surgeon in the world who is trained as both a plastic surgeon and urologist and has completed fellowships in both reconstructive urology and transgender surgery. He has been performing FTM surgery since 2005, and has worked extensively with [redacted] Belgium, I [redacted] in Serbia, and with [redacted] in Thailand. Good morning you may recall we sent you two patients in 2012/13 for FIM surgery. I also passed your contact details on to an endocrinologist who wrote to you referring one of his patients asking if you would provide GRS, and if so with a break down of your costs. Last contact I had with him he indicated that he hadn't heard from you.

As the Ministry funds a very limited number of GRS we would like to be able to choose a preferred overseas provider, we have also sent two patients to America for their GRS.

I am also conscious that we do not appear to have been invoiced for all the treatment provided to our two patients.

It would be good to know if you were interested in carrying out any further surgery for us, and if so who it is best to make contact with to pursue further.

Also to resolve some of the issues above.
