Dear Mr Riddell

I refer to the Official Information Act request you sent to the Prime Minister's office on 15 September 2015. You requested the following:

"In an answer to question 6 during Question Time today you [Prime Minister] stated that Treasury advice regarding a carbon emission reduction proposal for Paris included a recommendation to "do significantly less than the Government is taking to Paris". Please provide a copy of that advice, including all related reports, memos, emails, file notes and other records."

As you know, the Prime Minister's office transferred your request to the Treasury for response on 25 September 2015. The transfer was under section 14(b)(ii) of the Official Information Act, on the basis that the information sought is more closely connected to the functions and responsibilities of the Treasury.

Information Publicly Available
