Dear D Broome

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 7 November 2015 in which you requested information about the accuracy of speed measuring devices.

You requested:


I request a copy of the following documents or data:

A per speed-measuring device breakdown of the variance of accuracy before and after calibration for all devices tested in the past 12 months, the model and make of each, and non-repudiatable identifier for each device such as serial number.

Given that Police has in excess of 1,000 radar units and 1,500 antennas, it would take a substantial amount of time to collate and print lab reports for every device. Section 12(2) of the Official Information Act 1982 requires that requests for information be specified with due particularity. If you are able to define your request more clearly by advising which particular device you require this information for, I may be able to assist you. Otherwise I must refuse your request in terms of section 18(f) of the Official Information Act 1982.

You have the right to complain to the Ombudsman and seek an investigation and review of my decision if you are not satisfied with the way I have responded to your request.
