I discussed this with Greg last week and I was advised to pass this information on to you.

During December 2015/January 2016 stock of dexamfetamine 5mg tabs was is short supply, and some patients had to return to prescribers for alternative therapies. I Had several conversations with pharmacists wrt the number of tabs some patients were prescribed. The Medsafe data sheet recommends a maximum of 20mg per day.

Most patients on 4 tabs per day or less were able to manage until supply resumed as pharmacy dispensed small amounts on a weekly basis.

Several patients had prescriptions for 8 to 20 or more tabs per day, and it was these patients who were most affected by the OOS.

Pharmacists commented that a number of patients on large doses were young men who had been on dexamfetamine for a long time, and could potentially be on better treatment regimens and/or titrated off dexamfetamine.



We use HCL as our logistics provider for shipping of these controlled substances.

Normally the rules don't allow for shipments on Friday of controlled substances, because there isn't a guaranteed delivery option for most places on a Saturday, and the transportation companies do not have the facilities/processes storing the restricted substances over the weekend.
