- Section 6(a)—which relates to prejudice to the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of the New Zealand Government
- Section 6(c)—which relates to prejudice to the maintenance of the law
- Section 9(2)(a)— which relates to the privacy of natural persons
- Section 9(2)(b)(ii)—which relates to unreasonable prejudice to the commercial position of a person
- Section 9(2)(f)(iv)—which relates to the constitutional conventions which
 protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers or officials, and
- Section 9(2)(g)(i)—which relates to the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or to Ministers or officials.

In addition, some of the information contained in the Compliance Operations Branch Response Plan is publically available. Therefore the request for that information is refused under section 18(d) of the Act.
