It has gone through the process of public notification, received one objection, and the WCC rang today to confirm that, unless they have any further information, the best they can offer is one DC carpark outside the Embassy between 8am-6pm Monday to Friday s6(b)(i) I seem to recall in the past that DPS provided reports regarding security issues in support of carparking in front of missions. Are you able to provide a comment/report on whether NZ Police thinks there are valid reasons for security concerns outside the Iranian Embassy? We have attached the Embassy's Third Person Notes to us. The other issue is that the WCC would like a response from us by the end of this week, so that they can process this in the current round of carparking requests. It would be great if you are able to provide a comment to us for on passing to the WCC on NZ Police's views.
