I've spoken with the engineer, and unfortunately the proposed broken yellow lines outside No. Alberton Avenue could not be replaced with time-sensitive No-stopping restrictions. These broken yellow lines are necessary to ensure visibility around the zebra crossing, which could be used at any time.

However, you would be able to park at the proposed bus stop (i.e. outside #65, 67, and 69) outside of the operating hours.

Thanks for meeting with us on site for Alberton Avenue. We have had discussion with PT regarding the relocation of the bus stop from the originally proposed location(#24 Alberton Ave) to #28 as you have suggested. Given that this location is directly opposite the school gate and the bus stop will be further away from the zebra crossing, we both have concerns that school children will choose to cross the road directly after disembarking the bus or run across the road to catch the bus during school afternoon peak, instead of using the pedestrian crossing facility. After careful consideration and taking into account the behaviour of school children, we believe that it would be more ideal to keep the original proposal (relocate the bus stop to outside #24). We are happy to plant more trees at other locations on Alberton Ave as a result.

I have just received the following from a customer, via the CRM process:-

Last year, I wrote requesting traffic lights or a traffic-light pedestrian crossing on the south side of the intersection of Mt. Albert Road and Alberton Rd. You said that you couldn't put in traffic lights because of driveways and I accept that. However, I think that a traffic-light pedestrian crossing a little way before the intersection (in the direction of Sandringham, not the Mt. Albert shops) is vital.

With three schools in Alberton, both the vehicular and foot traffic are heavy. Every day, I see school children dodging traffic across Mt. Albert Road and my heart is in my mouth. There is a pedestrian island on the north side of the intersection; however, many children come from the south side or get off the bus on the other side of the road and don't go up to that island to cross.

There was also an island in Mt. Albert Road between Kerr Taylor Ave and Toroa Tce but that has been removed. I understand that there is also a change in bus routes so that many children who caught buses in New North Rd opposite Rocket Park will now have to go up to Mt. Albert Rd and cross it in order to get their buses.

As you know, 2 children were hit by cars on St. Luke's Road last term. I don't want my child or anyone else's child to be put at risk. My daughter and I were hit by a car while crossing to a traffic island in Greenlane a few years ago so they are not ideal.

I am positive that a section of road can be found, on the south side of the Mt. Albert/Alberton intersection, where a pedestrian crossing with lights can be put in. Children's lives should be a high priority, higher than fixing run-down-looking kerbs. I feel that my child's safety is being compromised by there not being a lighted pedestrian crossing at that location. I urge you to reconsider.

This appears to link closely to the measures currently being proposed to improve pedestrian safety in this area. Do you wish me to pass this to Rosita via the same process or ??

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this proposal.

I note that all I have been asked to do is state if the proposal complies with standards and practices Rapid Response use as well as if this impacts on proposals that RR have for the same locations. I am not sure that is what I would term consultation so I will make comments based on my knowledge of the area, on road safety and on the likely responses of customers to these proposals and its implications on consistency across the AT network.

Having identified that parking on the approach to the zebra crossing is an issue, it appears that AT are proposing to actually create a parking space on the approach. From a Rapid Response point of view, I would struggle to defend the retention of this parking space. I also note that two of the three bus stops straddle residential vehicle crossings and the length of bus stop specified in ATCOP (13.5 metres in length) does not match those that it is proposed to be provided.

I note that nothing is proposed to be done on the actual zebra crossing, which is felt to be unsatisfactory from a pedestrian safety and operational point of view, due to the location of vehicle entrance points to residential properties, in particular the vehicle entrances to #71 and #73 Alberton Avenue which utilise the pram crossing at the zebra crossing to access off street parking areas.
