
There is no outstanding fee with Auckland Transport, Baycorp or the Ministry of Justice with regards to infringement notice 3033498844.

Thank you for your correspondence about the above infringement notice (ticket).

After reviewing your explanation, and the reasons for the ticket, we have decided to proceed with enforcing the fee.

On the due date for payment shown above, you will be served with a reminder notice, this will give you another 28 days to pay or dispute the infringement notice.

**Reasons for the ticket**

Drivers are responsible for ensuring that any vehicle they drive or park on a road is licensed.

The vehicle must display a current licence label, or it must be stored off the road, on private property. This applies even if the car is not in use.

The relevant legislation is the Land Transport (Motor Vehicle Registration & Licensing) Regulations 2011 regulation 77(2)(b)(ii).

The New Zealand Transport Agency records confirm that, the licence (Rego) label expired on 06-Oct-2015 and was renewed on 11-Nov-2015 at 13:48hrs, the Infringement notice was issued on 11-Nov-2015 at 11:49hrs.

**What you need to do**

If you do not accept this decision, you can request a court hearing by completing the enclosed *Court Hearing Request* form and returning it to us. We will then advise you of the next steps.

If we do not receive the completed form, or payment, we may advise a debt-collection agency to recover the unpaid fee.

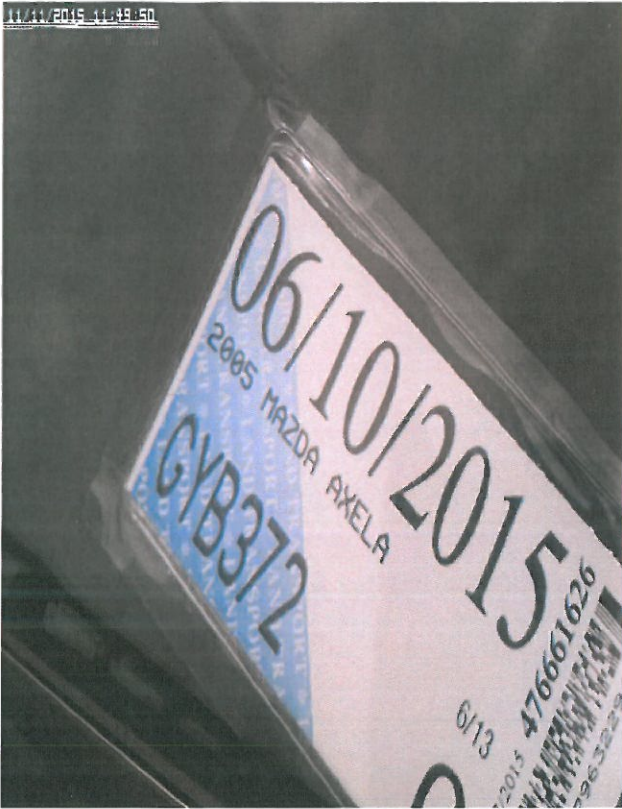

**Hearing** A formal session at court overseen by a judge or justice of the peace. At a hearing you can say why you should not have been fined and the prosecuting authority can say why they think you should be fined. The judge will then decide whether or not you should have been fined.

**Infringement** Breaking the law, where the law breaking is minor, like speeding or parking where you aren't supposed to.
